

## Important:

Make sure that your print settings do not 'auto size' or 'stretch to fit' this printed page. If you have a 'page scaling' option make sure it is set to 'none'. Allowing your printer to change the print size willmake the ring sizes shown below inaccurate. Make sure that you measure the paper strip with a ruler from home to ensure that it is correct.

## Option #1:

Cut this measurement strip out and follow the directions you found online. The cut that you make on the left hand side of the measurement strip should be right on the line.

Use a ruler at home to verify the accuracy of this measurement strip:

## Option # 2:

If you are using the circles to the right to find your ring size, it is still important to verify the accuracy of the measurement strip shown in option 1.

When you place your ring over the circle, you should just be able to see the entire circle inside of your ring. The printed circle should be touching the inside of the ring all of the way around.

The number inside the circle is the ring size.
